TIPS to prepare for the school year!

- Laptops and Electronic Devices
 - TIDE students are each assigned a laptop designed to support all of their courses.
 - Students may not draw, color, put stickers or any other labels and artwork on the laptops. Students will sign the SUHSD Technology Use Agreement when they pick up their laptops on August 16th. Since laptops are property of SUHSD, students will be responsible for any damages assessed.
 - There is no need to have cell phones or other personal electronic devices during class time. TIDE's policy is that when students enter each classroom, they will place their electronic devices in pocket charts (aka phone hotels) for the duration of the class period. Teachers will provide instructions for placing phones in the charts and retrieving them when students exit. This means no cell phones or other personal electronics can be out during class time.

Transportation to TIDE

- The SUHSD provides <u>bus transportation</u> to and from TIDE. The bus schedule, including stops for 2022-23, is located on our website <u>here.</u> Students who ride the SUHSD must complete a transportation registration form, also on our website. - The Marsh Road Shuttle can also be an option. Stops go through Menlo Park to and from Caltrain. The schedule is available here on our website.
- We have limited student parking on the TIDE campus. Senior students will have priority to apply for a parking permit for the school year. If requests exceed spots, we will hold a lottery. Students can also ride bikes, scooters or skateboard to TIDE. To do so safely, wear helmets and follow suggested <u>safe routes to TIDE</u>.
