Physical Education Course 1-Emphasizes instruction in the areas of physical fitness, socialization, teamwork, sportspersonship, health/wellness concepts, movement skills, and the knowledge of activities. The P.E. program at TIDE Academy promotes self-confidence, creates opportunities for goal-setting skills, and the lifelong benefits of wellness

Physical Education Course 2- Students are becoming more interested in their personal development and recognize the value of high-level physical performance for their future lives and careers. Tenth-graders continue to improve their cognitive functioning. As tenth-graders mature, their egocentrism decreases. Through social interaction they learn they are not the sole focus of attention. They are learning to express their emotions in more appropriate ways, and their moral reasoning is becoming increasingly sophisticated.
